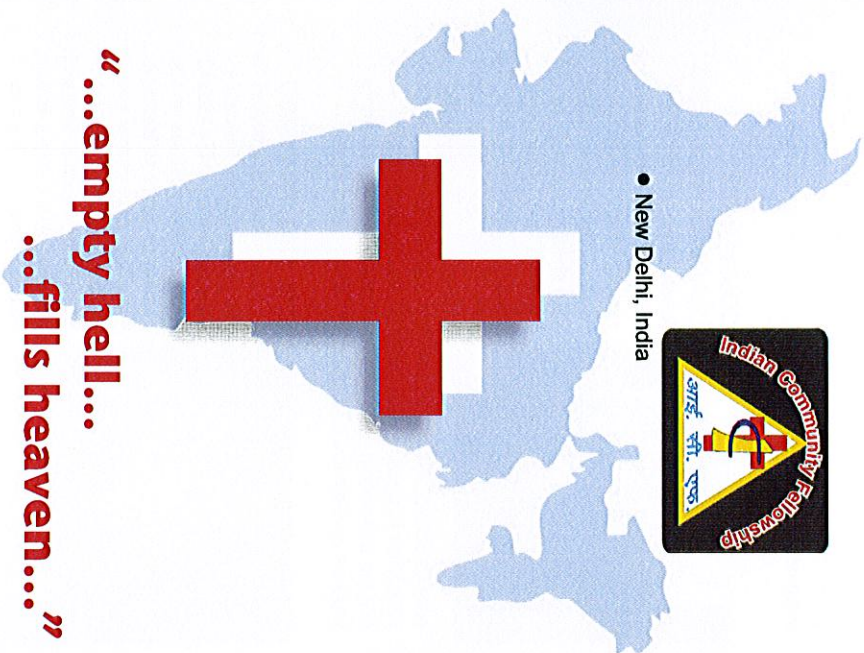


PASTORAL CARE

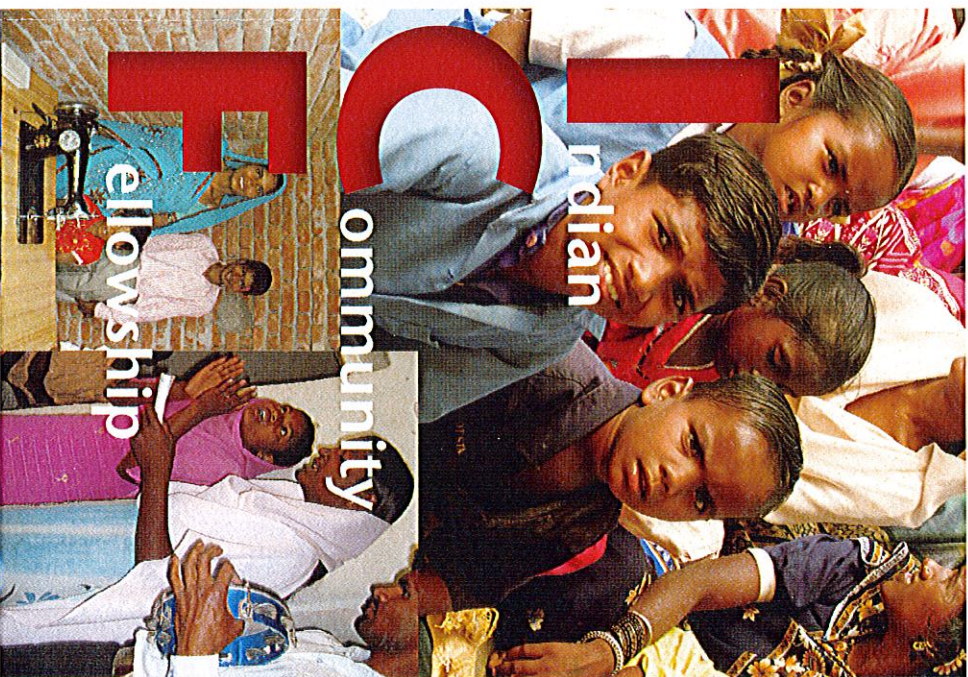
The DREAMS for the future.....

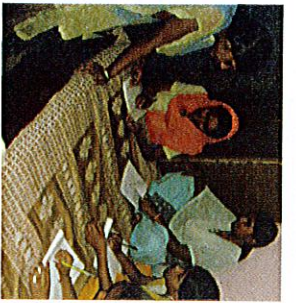

Computers for our pastors could lead to Biblical and lay-leader training by skype or video. Motor bikes for the pastors would allow them to go farther, in less time. An emergency medical fund would be a dream come true for serious life-or-death issues that are often faced by God's servants. And, the on-going dream of our own ICF training center is always foremost in our minds.

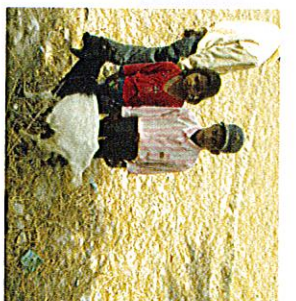

LITERACY CLASSES

55 women to date have attended literacy classes (which includes reading the Bible and writing the language), taught by 3 of our pastor's wives in three separate locations. We also have a daily literacy class in conjunction with our sewing school.



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

ICF has been giving village families sets of goats (male & female) for milk and breeding. When kids are born, they are passed on to more families. Efforts have also been made to provide leaders with bicycles, beginning with the pastors. In the future, we would like to see vitamins, medical supplies, and education available to all village families.



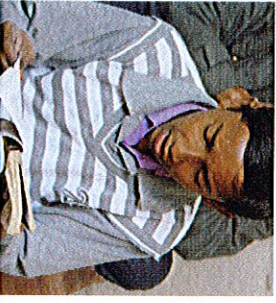
SEWING SCHOOL

This summer, 2011, will see the first graduates of our 12-month sewing school. Students are selected from applicants throughout the villages and attend class daily, learning tailoring, literacy and Bible classes. Upon graduation, they will receive a certificate, a sewing machine, and a Bible. More sewing schools are needed.



COMMUNITY LEADERS' TRAINING

Retreat-style trainings have been done for women in remote villages dealing with health & hygiene, working with children, women of the Bible, and relationship building (husband & wife and wife & mother-in-law). Our desire is to train a "medic" in each district with Red Cross First Aid and CPR training, education in dealing with general health concerns and disease prevention. We also need more trained children's workers and biblical education for laymen and women.



CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

A workshop was held in 2009 to train 20 village women to lead children's ministries. Now several congregations have weekly children's classes and special programs, including feeding plus caring for some orphans and fund-raising for school tutors for those where schools are available.



BIBLICAL TRAINING

Biblical training is provided for the pastors as the Executive Director, Pastor Philip Malakar takes seminary classes on line, passing on what he learns to the village pastors and when Dr. Gerald Wahr comes from America and spends time with the men. The pastors, in turn, pass on what they learn to the cell group leaders. Plans are being made for the Wahrs to come to India with a training team in the near future and to hold Biblical training courses by skype leading to a certificate. It is the dream of ICF to have our own training center, which will be safe & available.



BIBLE STUDIES & CELL GROUPS

61 lay leaders have been trained as ministry assistants in the churches and as leaders of the 790 active cell groups & Bible studies.
